HEALTH REGULATIONS

The Nebraska Department of Agriculture requires the following for out of state poultry entries:

Poultry who are NPIP:

VS Form 9-3

Preassigned out of state poultry permit

Originate from NPIP flock or hatchery

Poultry who are NON NPIP:

CVI (Health Certificate)

Pre-Entry Import Permit Number

Negative pullorum and typhoid test for each bird within 90 days prior to entry.

Junior-Ages 8-10 **Intermediate-**Ages 11-13 **Senior-** Ages 14 & up
Youth Club members receive 10 points for the 1st place in their class. 2nd Place receives a showmanship pin. Once a total of 30 points are accumulated the YEPA member is awarded in Advanced Showmanship Patch for the class they participate in. Applications for membership may be made at the show or may be filled out online on the youth club website. Applications must be made prior to the showmanship competition in order to be eligible for the awards points. Annual dues are \$8 per year for ages 5-18.

This is not a National Pigeon Association show, rather is intended for fun and to generate interest and diversity. Pigeons of any breed are welcome (Fantail to city pigeon), but please be aware that the judges may not be as familiar with some of the breeds, but will make every effort to make it an excellent show. Arrangements will be made for the reimbursement of the entry fees for any pigeons that exceed the 120 bird cut off limit.

APA EGG COMPETITION

Entries can be either mailed (Postmarked by Nov 13th) or entered Saturday of the show till Noon. Entries and Entry Fees can be mailed to: Vicki Gilliam – 13301 Raymond Road, Waverly, NE 68462. There are 3 divisions, feel free to enter one, any, or all. Multiple entries are welcome.

Entries are \$2.50 Each or 5 entries for \$10. (Correct change would be appreciated)

Awards will be \$10 each for best in Egg Quality, Painted and Decorated. Reserve will be \$5 Each. Overall Champion of APA Egg Competition \$20 in memory of Mark Fields.

Egg Quality – An entry in this division is 3 uniform eggs. The four categories of eggs are: Large Fowl, Bantam, Waterfowl, Other Fowl.

Within the categories we will sort by egg color. The best of each color will compete for best in their category. The best in each category will compete for best display.

Each entry will be evaluated using 6 categories: Weight & Breed Correctness, Shape, Size, Shell Texture, Appearance & Uniformity, and Internal Quality (one egg will be broken open)

Painted Egg Competition – 1 Egg per entry. Open and Junior classes (note which category: 5-10 yrs, 11-16 yrs, or adult). Egg must be hard boiled or blown. Egg is painted or inked. No adornments or decorations added. Some type of upright support is recommended. Egg must be painted/inked by exhibitor.

Decorated Egg Competition – 1 Egg per entry. Open and Junior classes (note which category: 5-10 years, 11-16 years or adult). Egg must be hard boiled or blown. Egg is to be adorned or decorated but may have paint added. Outline of Egg must be recognizable. Egg decoration must be created by the exhibitor.

You are not required to enter a bird in the show to enter the egg show.
