Paper Entries

- Online entries must be completed before 12:00 am CST, November 5.

Show Check-in

Upon arrival, check-in at the Show Secretary Table with a copy of your registration and any health paperwork and entry permits issued.

Report coop tag changes to the Show Secretary as soon as issues are identified including any scratches.

Membership

Junior Program

Birds entered by Junior exhibitors receive free entry in the Open Show as a two-card show.

Showmanship will be available for juniors. Sign-ups are at the Show Secretary Table during coop-in. There will also be Breed ID and Defect ID contests. Junior Breed ID and Defect ID entries must be turned in to the Show Secretary Table by 4:00 PM on Saturday, November 16.

Out of State Exhibitors

All out of state exhibitors must complete the Nebraska Department of Ag Import Poultry Permit. The form can be found at nda.nebraska.gov/animal/poultry/ImportPoultryPermit2025.pdf. Necessary forms can be sent with registration or submitted at show check-in. Cooping-in cannot be allowed for out of state exhibitors until paperwork has been submitted. Paperwork can be picked-up prior to departure of the show at the Show Secretary's Table. Full details about NDA's requirements can be found on their web site at nda.nebraska.gov/animal/poultry/.

NPIP Flocks

- Birds must be accompanied by VS Form 9-3.
- Obtain a pre-assigned Out of State Annual Poultry Permit (link above).
- Originate from an NPIP Participating flock, hatchery or dealer.

Non-NPIP Flocks

- Birds must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary
- Inspection obtained from your local veterinarian.
- Obtain a permit for entry (link above).
- Be tested negative for pollorum-typhoid within 90 days of importation.

Show Rules

The NSPA cannot facilitate substitutions once entries are made and does not issue refunds.

The NSPA, nor its officers, will be responsible for any theft, accidents/injury, loss or sickness to any bird. However, all precautions will be taken to protect exhibits.

Show boxes or containers used for the transport of birds, tack, or other personal belongings with exhibitor labels must be completely covered or removed for judging.

No straw is allowed for bedding. Wood chip bedding will be provided. **NSPA is excited for Nutrena's support of our show.**

Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their own birds. **NO FEED, FEED CUPS, OR WATER CUPS WILL BE PROVIDED. PLAN TO BRING YOUR OWN OR PURCHASE FROM SHOW VENDORS.**

NSPA reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Only judges and show officials will be allowed in aisles closed for judging.

No one is permitted to handle birds other than their own without permission from the owner or show management.

NSPA is not responsible for any awards donated by anyone other than the NSPA.

All Runner Ducks must have numbered leg bands on. Runners will be ring-judged.

For displays and trios, at least three entries must be entered in each division for awards to be given. Chicken displays consist of one each of cock, hen, cockerel, pullet, and either a young or old trio of the same breed/variety. Waterfowl displays consist of one each of old male, old female, young male, young female, and three other birds of the same breed/variety.

Classes must have ten entries for champion and reserve champion awards to be given.

This is a sanctioned APA Show where their rules are upheld. Officials of the NSPA will decide situations not covered by the aforementioned rules.



Backyard Beauty

New for 2024!

Here is your opportunity to share the truly unique birds in your flock! The Backyard Beauty Contest is for the color project, breeding mishap, farm store special, or bird of unknown origin. Judging will be based on condition and true unique beauty.

Double coops are only available for large fowl and heavy ducks.

Entry fee is \$5 per bird. Entries can be double entered in the open or junior show. An additional entry fee is required for double-entered birds.

Silent Auction

The NSPA will host a silent auction of curated items. A key draw for the auction are donated breeding pairs from the flocks of exhibitors. Donated birds should be healthy young birds representative of their breed.

As a thank you, exhibitors donating a pair of birds to the silent auction will receive a \$10 discount on entry fees.

Silent auction coops will be labeled with donor's name and the breed and variety of the birds. Exhibitors may donate more than one pair, but the maximum discount is \$10. Birds must be cooped-in by 8:30 AM on Saturday, November 16 in the auction area. Birds entered in the show are not eligible.

Entries can be made in advance on either the paper form or online in the web store meeting published deadlines OR in-person at show check-in. Entries must be completed and on display on the designated tables by 9:00 AM on Saturday, November 16.

Egg entries are \$2.50 per entry or \$10 for 5 entries.

Awards will be \$5 each for best in Egg Quality, Painted, and Decorated. Reserve awards are \$3 each. The Overall APA Egg Show Champion will receive \$10 in memory of Mark Fields.

Egg Quality

An entry in this division is 3 uniform eggs. The four categories of eggs are: Large Fowl, Bantam, Waterfowl, and Other Fowl. Within the categories we will sort by egg color. The best batch of each color will compete for best in their category. The best of each category will compete for best display. Each entry will be evaluated on weight and breed correctness, shape, size, shell texture, appearance and uniformity, and internal quality. One egg will be broken open.

Painted Egg Competition

1 egg per entry. Open and junior classes. Egg must be hard boiled or blown. Egg is painted or inked. No adornments or decorations can be added. Some type of upright support is recommended. Egg must be painted by the exhibitor.

Decorated Egg Competition

1 egg per entry. Open and junior classes. Egg must be hard boiled or blown. Egg is to be adorned or decorated but may have paint added. Outline of egg must be recognizable. Egg decoration must be the work of the exhibitor.



Sale Coops and Trailers

Exhibitors are permitted to sell birds during the show. Reserved indoor parking is available for pre-paid sale trailers. An area of sale coops will also be designated. Birds entered in the show may be sold but not removed from their coops until all birds are released following the awards ceremony. Sale spaces can be purchased as a part of pre-entry or at show check-in at the Show Secretary's Table.

The NSPA is not responsible for any sales. All transactions take place between sellers and buyers.
